healthcare personnel for fever and COVID-19 symptoms at the start and end of their shift. Is it really required to screen both times?	Regardless of the frequency of testing being performed or the facility's COVID-19 status, the facility should continue to screen all staff (each shift), each resident (daily), and all persons entering the facility, such as vendors, volunteers, and visitors, for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.			
	Screening should take place at the beginning of the shift. While screening at the end of the shift would be desirable as another data point, it is <u>not</u> required.
