At our skilled nursing facility, we screen each staff member at the beginning of their shift. PA-HAN-530 says to actively screen all healthcare personnel for fever and COVID-19 symptoms at the start and end of their shift. Is it really required to screen both times?	<p>On page 3 of CMS Memorandum (Ref. QSO-20-38-NH) dated 8/26/2020 with the subject <i>Interim Final Rule (IFC), CMS-3401-IFC, Additional Policy and Regulatory Revisions in Response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency related to Long-Term Care (LTC) Facility Testing Requirements and Revised COVID-19 Focused Survey Tool</i> it states:</p> <p><i>Regardless of the frequency of testing being performed or the facility’s COVID-19 status, the facility should continue to screen all staff (each shift), each resident (daily), and all persons entering the facility, such as vendors, volunteers, and visitors, for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.</i></p> <p>Screening should take place at the beginning of the shift. While screening at the end of the shift would be desirable as another data point, it is <u>not</u> required.</p>
